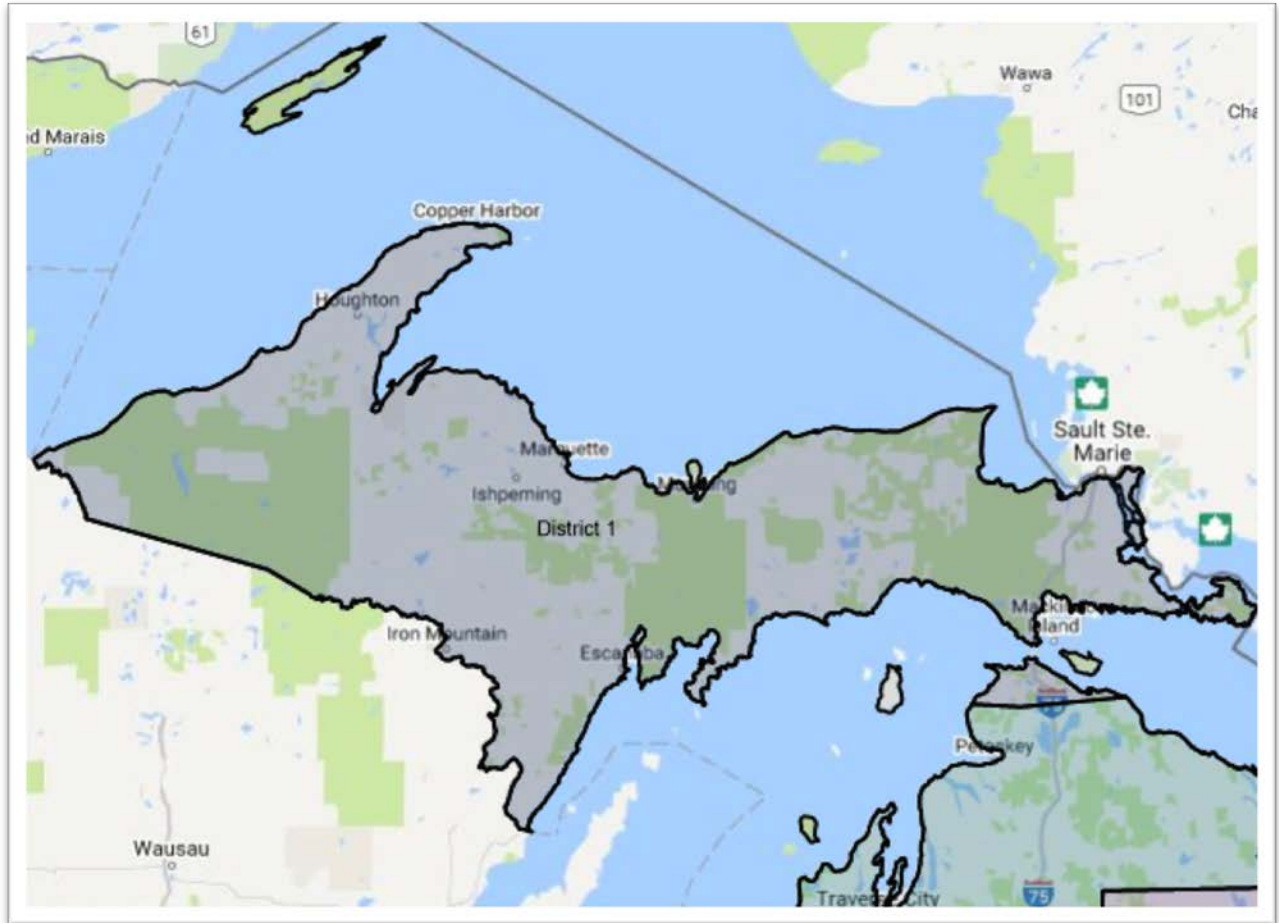


District 1
